Introduction



Yashchenko Foundation in Numbers

As we reflect on the past quarter, the Yashchenko Foundation remains steadfast in its commitment to supporting communities across Ukraine. This report highlights the breadth of our activities, from delivering essential aid to vulnerable regions to enhancing our logistics capabilities and fostering life-saving initiatives such as the Walking Blood Bank.

In response to the escalating humanitarian needs, we have significantly scaled up our aid distribution efforts. Over the last three months, we delivered critical supplies to Northern, Eastern, Southern, and Western Ukraine, ensuring hospitals, displaced families, and front-line communities received the resources they needed. Whether it was providing insulation materials for winter, delivering medical supplies valued at over £20,000 in Mykolaiv, or bringing Christmas cheer to children and families, our work has aimed to address both immediate and long-term needs.

Our operations have been further strengthened by the addition of a Volkswagen Crafter to our fleet, generously donated by the Adderstone Foundation and Gavin Dunn. This vehicle marks an important milestone in our goal to build a robust and efficient logistics network capable of reaching even the most remote and challenging locations.

One of the stand-out achievements this quarter has been our partnership in the Walking Blood Bank initiative, which has already helped register thousands of voluntary blood donors across Ukraine. By increasing access to donor blood, this programme is saving lives and reducing the long-term consequences of injuries during these critical times.

The Yashchenko Foundation's work would not be possible without the generosity of our partners and supporters. Together, we are making a tangible difference, bringing hope and resilience to communities facing extraordinary challenges. Thank you for your ongoing support of our work.

Aid Delivery Report




In October, the Yashchenko Foundation continued its critical aid distribution across Ukraine, delivering essential supplies to communities in need. Northern Ukraine saw a delivery to Chernihiv, which included tools, clothes, diapers, shoes, and insulation foil.

Eastern Ukraine received substantial support with deliveries to Dnipro of water filters, adult diapers, gloves, and LED lights, and to Zaporizhzhia with ambulance stretchers, spine-boards, helmets, stabilizing equipment for broken bones, airways equipment, IV tubes, and needles.

Meanwhile, in Western and Central Ukraine we delivered EldonCards (blood type test kits) to Kyiv and distributed clothes, toys, food, hard hats, high-visibility jackets, steel-capped boots, and more in Lvivska Oblast. In total, the Foundation distributed over 4.7 tonnes of aid across Ukraine in October.




October Deliveries



November marked a significant month for the Foundation's efforts in Eastern and Southern Ukraine. Zaporizhzhia received fire extinguishers, police high-visibility jackets, and trauma bags. Kharkiv saw critical aid with deliveries including an emergency ambulance donated to one of the hospitals in the city and a comprehensive package of medical and hospital supplies such as urinary basins, leg splints, sleep apnoea machines, catheters, and bedding. A separate delivery to Kharkiv included hospital beds, wheelchairs, bath chairs, walkers, and other essential equipment, totalling 9.7 tonnes. Nikopol, in Dnipropetrovsk Oblast received Christmas gifts, food, and hygiene products. We also made aid deliveries to Sumska and Cherkaska Oblasts.

In Southern Ukraine, Mykolaiv received a consignment of medical supplies and medications valued at over £20,000. This included a wide range of critical pharmaceuticals and medical equipment, ensuring local healthcare providers could continue to address acute and chronic health needs. Kherson received toys, while various locations across Ukraine received a wide array of essential items, including syringes, hygiene products, clothes, and mattresses. In Kropyvnytskyi, school desks and chairs were delivered to equip a school bomb shelter so that the children could finally return to offline lessons after nearly three years, and Lviv received waterproofing spray to support the construction of IDP Accommodation. The total aid distributed in November exceeded 36 tonnes.


December was a month of both practical aid and festive cheer. In Chernihiv, the Foundation distributed hundreds of Christmas presents alongside hygiene products, clothes, and toys. Essential items such as insulation materials, winter clothing, and other supplies were also delivered, ensuring families could prepare for the colder months. These distributions provided much-needed relief and support for daily living.

In Kherson, Christmas boxes were delivered, containing sweets, hygiene products, and small festive items for children and adults. In Skvyra, Kyivska Oblast, displaced families received Christmas gifts, helping to foster a sense of community and celebration despite their challenging circumstances.

These distributions focused not only on addressing immediate needs but also on spreading hope and a sense of normalcy during the holiday season. Over 1.6 tonnes of aid were delivered in December, with a significant emphasis on ensuring that children and families felt supported and cared for.

Walking Blood Bank

In October 2023, DonorUA and Eldon Biologicals launched the “Walking Blood Bank” project, which the Yashchenko Foundation proudly joined shortly thereafter. The Walking Blood Bank aims to expand Ukraine’s pool of voluntary blood donors, ensuring a steady and reliable supply of donor blood for civilians and hospitals. This initiative is particularly vital in the context of the ongoing Russian invasion, where immediate access to donor blood can significantly improve survival rates and reduce the number of amputations.

The project operates on two key strategies. First, it seeks to rapidly increase the number of blood donors and donations at blood centres across the country. Second, it establishes a network of registered blood donors whose contact details allow healthcare institutions to call upon them during emergencies, ensuring timely blood donations when urgent needs arise.

During its first year, the Walking Blood Bank facilitated blood typing for 5,944 Ukrainians, helping them discover their blood type and register as donors. This milestone was achieved through 236 blood-typing events held across 14 cities, showcasing the project’s wide-reaching impact. By strengthening Ukraine’s emergency response capacity, the Walking Blood Bank underscores the critical role of community involvement in saving lives and supporting the nation during a time of immense need.

The Yashchenko Foundation is thrilled to announce the addition of a new Volkswagen Crafter to our fleet, generously donated by the Adderstone Foundation and Gavin Dunn. This versatile vehicle significantly enhances our logistics capabilities, enabling us to transport larger quantities of aid more efficiently to communities across Ukraine.

The Crafter represents a key step towards our broader fleet development goals. The Foundation ultimately aims to build a robust fleet comprising 16 Volkswagen Crafters and 8 transporters, alongside other specialist vehicles tailored to meet specific operational needs. These additions will enable us to deliver aid faster and more reliably, particularly to hard-to-reach areas and conflict zones.

We are hugely grateful to the Adderstone Foundation and Gavin Dunn for their generous contribution, which directly supports our mission of delivering life-saving assistance to those in need. As we expand our fleet, we look forward to strengthening our capacity to respond to the growing humanitarian needs across Ukraine.
