

Introduction

Yashchenko Foundation in Numbers

During the fourth quarter of 2025, Yashchenko Foundation continued to deliver targeted humanitarian assistance across Ukraine whilst significantly scaling our blood programme. The quarter combined large-scale medical distributions and critical winterisation support for front-line communities.

In October, the Foundation delivered over 19 tonnes of medical aid to hospitals and primary health care facilities across Dnipropetrovska, Kyivska, Poltavska, Khmelnytska, and Ternopil'ska oblasts, supporting facilities facing persistent shortages and supply chain disruption.

In November, activity shifted toward winterisation and household support in Sumska oblast, where nearly 60 tonnes of aid were delivered to front-line communities close to the Russian border. These distributions provided essential bedding, hygiene items, and household supplies during the most challenging winter period.

Although December is typically a quieter operational month, the Foundation continued targeted support to displaced families, children, and emergency services, including deliveries of clothing, children's items, and specialist equipment in Dnipropetrovska, Kharkivska, Mykolaivska, and Zaporizka oblasts.

Q4 also marked a major scale-up of the Walking Blood Bank (WBB) programme. With funding from Direct Relief, the Foundation conducted 34,288 blood-group tests, recruiting thousands of new donors. Front-line testing exceeded targets, with over 4,000 tests delivered across seven oblasts, strengthening Ukraine's emergency medical readiness.

During the quarter, Yashchenko Foundation was formally granted UK charitable status, strengthening governance and enabling deeper engagement with institutional donors.

As the year draws to a close, I would like to extend my sincere thanks to our donors, partners, and supporters for standing with us throughout 2025. Your trust and continued support have made this work possible, and remain essential as humanitarian needs continue to grow.

Aid Delivery Report




In October, Yashchenko Foundation delivered over 19 tonnes of medical aid across Ukraine, with distributions focused almost entirely on essential pharmaceuticals for hospitals and primary health care facilities facing persistent shortages. Deliveries were concentrated in Dnipropetrovska, Kyivska, Poltavska, Khmelnytska, and Ternopil'ska oblasts, reflecting continued pressure on regional health systems.

The largest volume of assistance was delivered in Dnipropetrovska oblast, including Nikopol, Dnipro, Pavlohrad, and Synelnykove. Facilities received critical medicines such as adult and paediatric antibiotics, cardiovascular and endocrine treatments, antidepressants, antiviral and antifungal drugs, oncology medicines, anaesthetics, and chronic disease treatments, helping stabilise depleted stocks amid ongoing disruption to supply chains.

In Kyiv and Poltavska oblasts, medical aid was distributed through municipal health facilities and trusted civil society partners, supporting both resident populations and internally displaced people. These deliveries focused on antibiotics, psychotropic medicines, cardiovascular treatments, and other essential drugs required for routine and emergency care.

Additional consignments to Khmelnytska and Ternopil'ska oblasts supported district hospitals and community partners, including targeted deliveries of medicines for HIV/AIDS patients and broad-spectrum pharmaceutical support.


Aid Delivery Report

In November, Yashchenko Foundation conducted our largest distribution to date totalling nearly 60 tonnes of humanitarian aid to front-line communities in Sum'ska oblast, with distributions focused on winterisation, WASH, and household support as temperatures dropped and civilian infrastructure remained under pressure.

Large-scale deliveries reached vulnerable households in the Velykopysariv'ska and Okhtyr'ska communities, including the villages of Dobryanske, Kyrkyivka, and Hrun, all located close to the Russian border and regularly affected by shelling and disruption to basic services. Assistance included winter bedding kits, kitchen sets, solar lamps, thermos flasks, hygiene kits designed to cover three months, and adult diapers for elderly and vulnerable residents.

These distributions significantly strengthened household resilience ahead of winter, providing families with essential items to maintain warmth, hygiene, and basic living conditions during periods of limited power supply and restricted access to services.

November marked a shift in focus from medical aid to community-level winter support, reflecting seasonal needs and the Foundation's ability to adapt programming rapidly to changing conditions on the ground.






December is typically a quieter operational month; however, Yashchenko Foundation continued to deliver targeted assistance to vulnerable groups and essential services, distributing approximately 12 tonnes of aid across Dnipropetrovska, Kharkivska, Mykolaivska, and Zaporizka oblasts.

In Dnipropetrovska oblast, distributions focused on clothing and children’s items, including deliveries to transit locations supporting internally displaced families and to local charitable and faith-based organisations assisting vulnerable communities. These consignments provided winter clothing and essential items during the coldest period of the year.

Targeted support was also provided to SOS Children’s Villages in Kharkiv and Mykolaiv, with deliveries of children’s gifts and clothing aimed at supporting displaced and vulnerable children during the winter period.

In Zaporizhzhia, assistance included children’s clothing delivered to a city children’s hospital, alongside specialised equipment provided to local emergency services. Deliveries of fire hoses to State Fire and Rescue Departments strengthened local emergency response capacity in an area regularly affected by attacks and infrastructure damage.

Although lower in volume than preceding months, December’s distributions ensured continued support to vulnerable children, displaced families, and essential emergency services, maintaining the Foundation’s presence and responsiveness through the winter period.



Walking Blood Bank



Progress Report

During Q4, Yashchenko Foundation significantly scaled up the Walking Blood Bank (WBB) programme, with expansion made possible through funding provided by Direct Relief. This support enabled a rapid increase in testing capacity and the extension of operations into front-line and hard-to-reach locations.

Over the quarter, 34,288 blood-group tests were conducted, recruiting thousands of new blood donors into Ukraine's emergency blood response system. Testing was delivered through a coordinated national network, including DonorUA teams, regional blood centres, family doctors, Yashchenko Foundation field teams, and local partners, ensuring wide geographic coverage and integration with existing health systems.

In parallel, the Foundation prioritised front-line access. Dedicated WBB teams conducted over 4,000 tests in front-line locations across Mykolaivska, Kharkivska, Khersonska, Dnipropetrovska, Zaporizka, Sumska, and Chernihivska oblasts, significantly exceeding the programme's key performance indicator of 3,000 front-line tests.

The Q4 scale-up demonstrates the programme's operational maturity and its ability to deliver high-volume, decentralised blood-typing at pace. By expanding both national and front-line testing, the WBB is strengthening Ukraine's emergency medical readiness and reducing delays in accessing compatible blood in critical situations.

Looking ahead to Q1, the programme will focus on completing the 150,000-test KPI, further expanding front-line coverage to new communities and strengthening integration with regional blood centres and hospitals. This next phase will consolidate gains made during Q4 and continue to improve rapid access to compatible blood for patients in critical, life-saving situations.


